Lacey's classmates thought it sounded like a good idea, and Lacey did too. They quickly chose which hymn they wanted to sing.

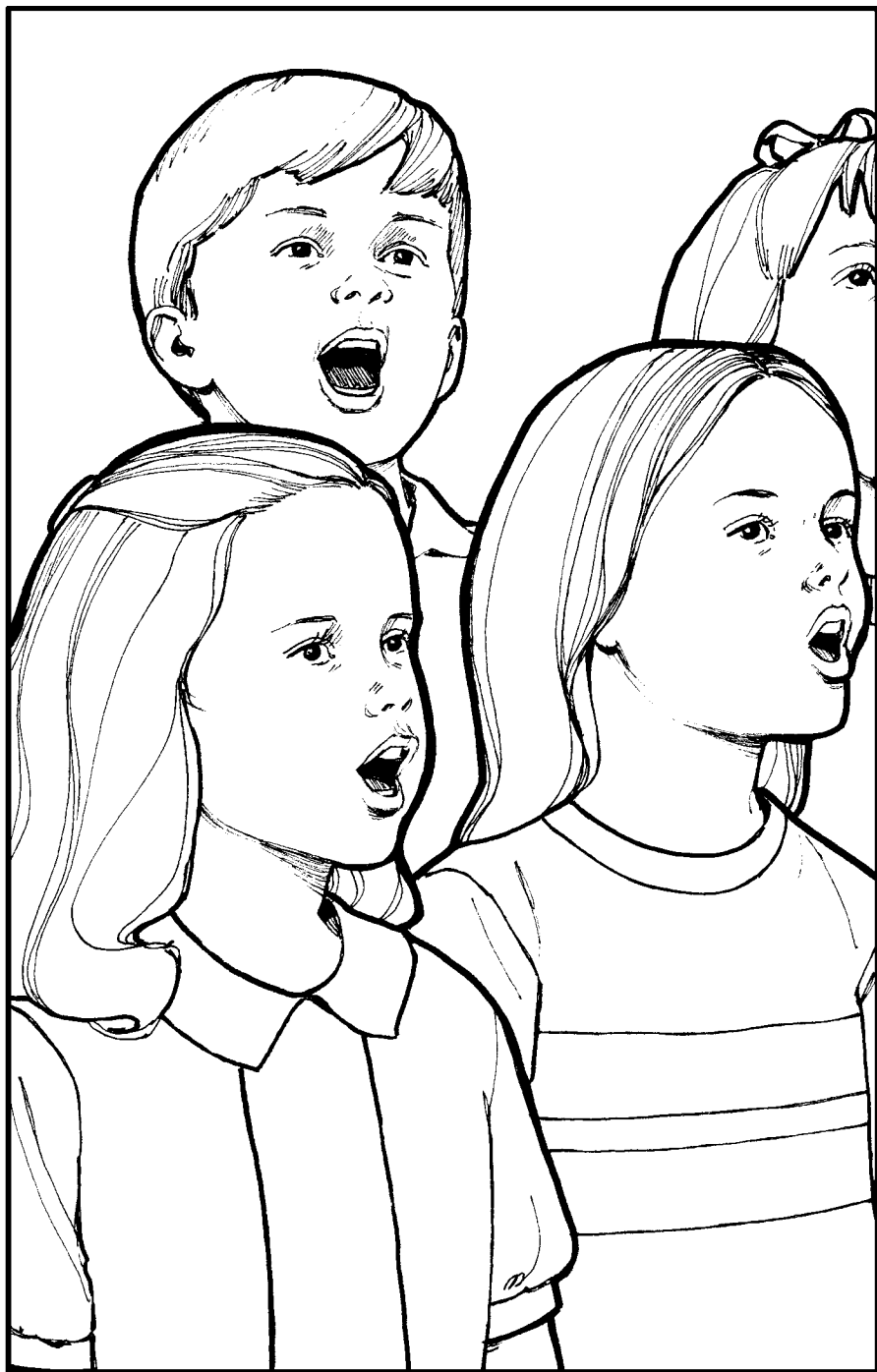
When the day came for the special program, Lacey went with her mom to the shopping mall. They gathered with other members of their church who were also going to sing.

God's Servant MOSES

Numbers 16:23-34

Three Israelite men, Korah, Dathan, and Abiram, sinned against the Lord by rebelling against God's servant Moses. The Lord was going to punish them for their sin.

God had Moses tell all the Israelites to stand far away from the tents where the three men and their families lived.

"Do not touch anything that is theirs, or you may be punished too," Moses warned the Israelites.
