**1 THESS. 1:1** Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

**2 We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;**

3 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;

**4 Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.**

5 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

**6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:**

7 So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.

**8 For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.**

9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;

**10 And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, even Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.**

# A New Loyalty

Lesson Text: I Thessalonians 1:1-10

Related Scriptures: Acts 17:1-4; Romans 6:17-23;  
I Corinthians 2:1-5; Ephesians 2:1-13

TIME: A.D. 51

PLACE: from Corinth

**GOLDEN TEXT**—“They themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God” (I Thessalonians 1:9).

## *Preparing to Teach the Lesson*

### **TODAY'S AIM**

**Facts:** to show how the new believers in Thessalonica turned from their idols and their old way of life to the living God.

**Principle:** to learn that when we put our faith in Christ, we become brand-new people.

**Application:** to turn around and know exciting new life in our Lord Jesus despite our past.

### **INTRODUCING THE LESSON**

A Christian organization reported the healing of a Hindu woman in India who had been sick for ten years. When the missionaries came and prayed for her, she was healed and turned from her previous faith to our Lord Jesus. This is a good example of the way that the message of Jesus transforms people and turns them toward Him, away from idols.

### **DEVELOPING THE LESSON**

**1. Remembered by Paul (I Thess. 1:1-3).** Paul tells us that Jesus is pre-eminent in all his preaching, and He

is the cause for which he was doing everything.

Notice the detail with which Paul prays for these believers. He remembers them and goes on to recount specific details of their faithfulness. They showed patience and love. These were marks of change.

Through faith in Jesus, we become new people. We are free from sin and realize that only the true and living God can do this. The past is left behind. The Thessalonian believers are a good example for us to follow. If someone looks at our own local churches, will they be able to give this kind of a report about us?

**2. Chosen by God (I Thess. 1:4-7).** In verse 4, Paul talks about “your election of God. Paul goes on to explain that the gospel is powerful. This is seen in the way the good news is powerfully demonstrated (the word here gives us the idea of *explosive* power).

The gospel demands a response. Paul commended the believers in Thessalonica for their close relationship with Jesus.
